CHIROPRACTIC HISTORY - Cousin Frank and the Halcyon Days of the PSC *with Alana Callender, Ed.D.*

Frank Elliott helped BJ Palmer develop the science and philosophy of chiropractic in the 1920's. Frank Elliott was Mabel Palmer's cousin and is frequently characterized that way. He could also be described as the business manager of the Palmer School of Chiropractic; part owner of the **neurocalometer**; Iowa state representative; radio pioneer; and chiropractor. He and his wife were part of the "**Green Book Gang**", the group of young faculty families in the 1920s at the PSC. We will discuss Dr. Elliott's involvement with the profession and the history of the event that led to the schism of the chiropractic profession that was centered around the Neurocalometer.
